Capt. Theel spoke on helicopter aviation and the Coast Guard.






## **Commissioning of USCGC Tunnell**


On Friday October 15, 2021, the Commandant of the USCG, Admiral Karl Schultz, along with the Superintendent of the US Coast Guard Academy, Admiral William Kelly, attended the commissioning ceremony of a USCG Cutter in Philadelphia at Penns Landing. The Commissioning ceremony was for the newest fast response cutter named the USCG Cutter Emlen Tunnell. Emlen Tunnell was from Radnor, Pennsylvania and served in Coast Guard during WWII. During the 1950's Tunnell played for the NY Giants and became first African American in NFL hall of fame. The NFL was represented by the Mara family, who owns the NY Giants. Division 4 was represented by Scott Sigman as an event usher, Andy Crowley and Bob Lynch in culinary services, and the event chaplain was Father Rex, Auxiliary Chaplain Service.
